

The Salon Professional Academy establishes a criterion regarding the transfer of credit hours earned from another school as listed below:

All accepted transfer hours will be credited at the beginning of the program.

- Possibility exists that no transfer credit will be granted.
- Transfers from another Salon Professional Academy will be placed into an existing class based on the level of completion recorded on their transcripts. Tuition balances do not transfer from one school to another.
- A student wishing to transfer may be accepted to an educational course/program after carefully evaluating the student's academic records.
- Each transfer is evaluated on an individual basis.
- Students must complete theory and practical training unique to our franchise system. The Cosmetology/Barbering-specific classes include Principal Design and Finishing, Color, Business Building Skills, Art of Consultation, and Product knowledge for 350 hours. Esthetics and Nail Technology will include business-building skills for a total of 25 hours
- Courses with an 85% or higher grade will be eligible for transfer hour's credit with a maximum of 100% of the student's completed hours allowable for transfer in general education chapters.

No transfer hours will be granted for the instructor program.

- All transfer students will pay the current contract price per hour for all remaining hours to fulfill graduation requirements.
- Transfer students will be subject to over-contract fees, if applicable.
